The Powerhouse Corporate Findings

Since we opened our doors in 2004 we have.....

Our <u>Intervention</u> component has shaped and empowered the minds & literacy skills of three hundred and eighty one (381) males. Three hundred sixty-six (366) African-American males, thirteen (13) Caucasian males and two (2) Hispanic/Latino males. *(*unduplicated*)

Our <u>Prevention</u> component has shaped and empowered the minds & literacy skills of one hundred and sixty four (164) males. One hundred and twenty two (122) African-American males & twenty one (21) Caucasian males, nine (9) Hispanic/Latino and twelve (12) Bi-racial. *(*unduplicated*)

Our <u>Prevention (Alternative Education)</u> component has shaped and empowered the minds and literacy skills of thirty one (**31**) males. Twenty two (**22**) African-American males & five (**5**) Caucasian males, four (**4**) Hispanic/Latino.

Prevention- Fiscal Year 2018-2019 served **(53)** AA males (44), Caucasian males (5), Hispanic male (3), Bi-racial (1). Two **(51)** were new to our program

<u>Prevention (Alternative Education)</u> Fiscal Year 2018-2019 served **(20)** AA males (13), and Caucasian males (4), Hispanic male (3), Bi-racial (0). Ten **(10)** were new to our program

□Forty-one (41) participants have received their G.E.D.
□ Sixty-Six (66) received a High School Diploma
□ Two (2) High School Certificates of Completion
□ Thirty-six (36) enrolled in college
□ Five (5) enlisted in Armed Forces
□Nine (9) enrolled in Job Corps
□One hundred and thirty (130) were able to re-enroll back into high school
